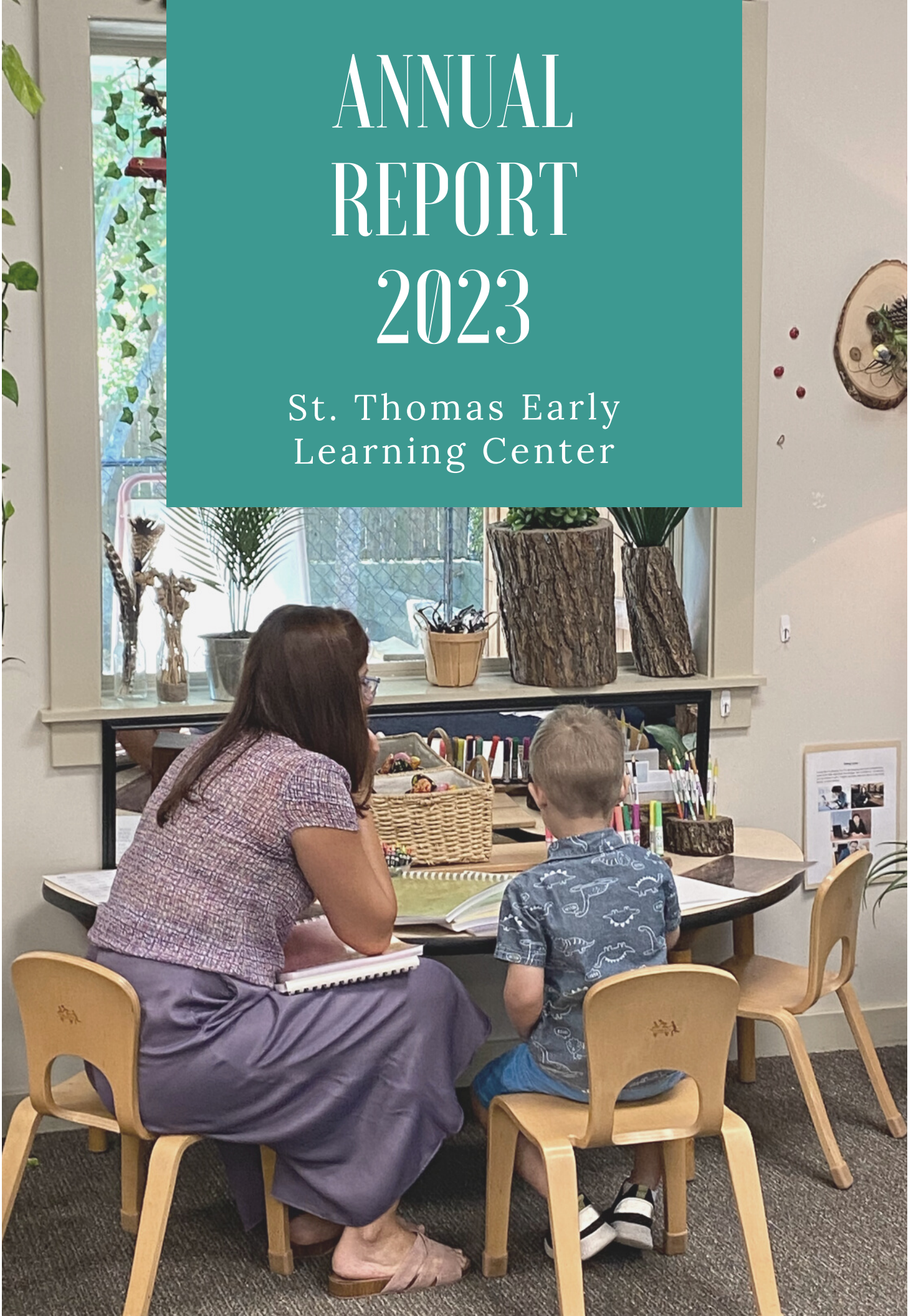

To create kind, curious learners and leaders in the Brazos Valley



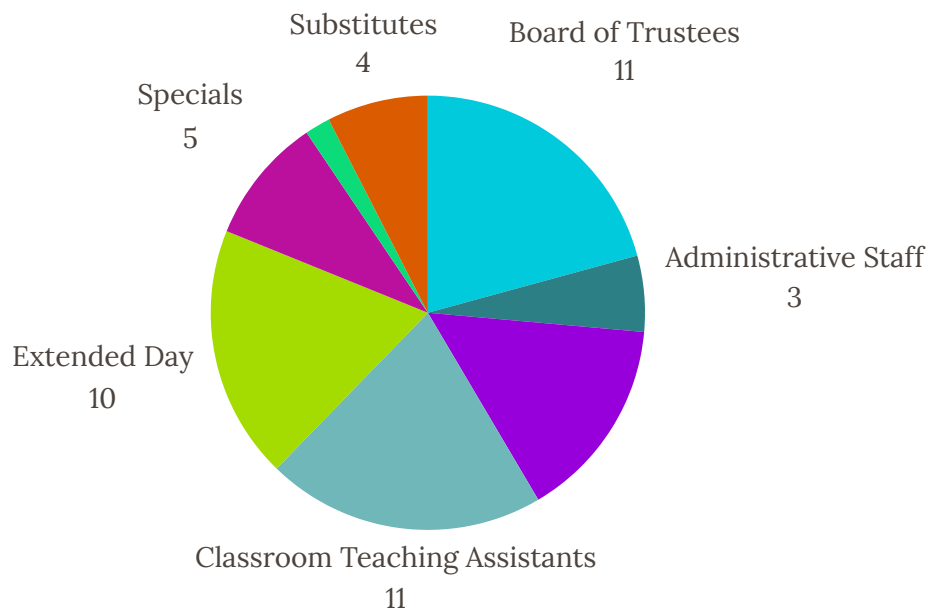

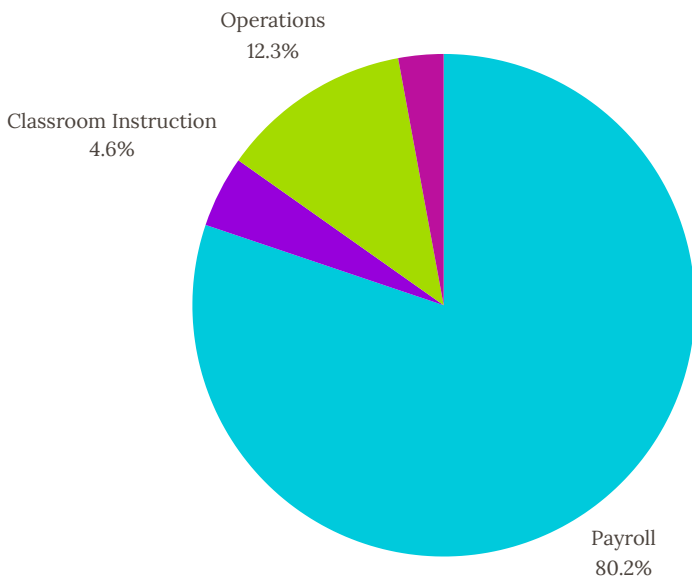




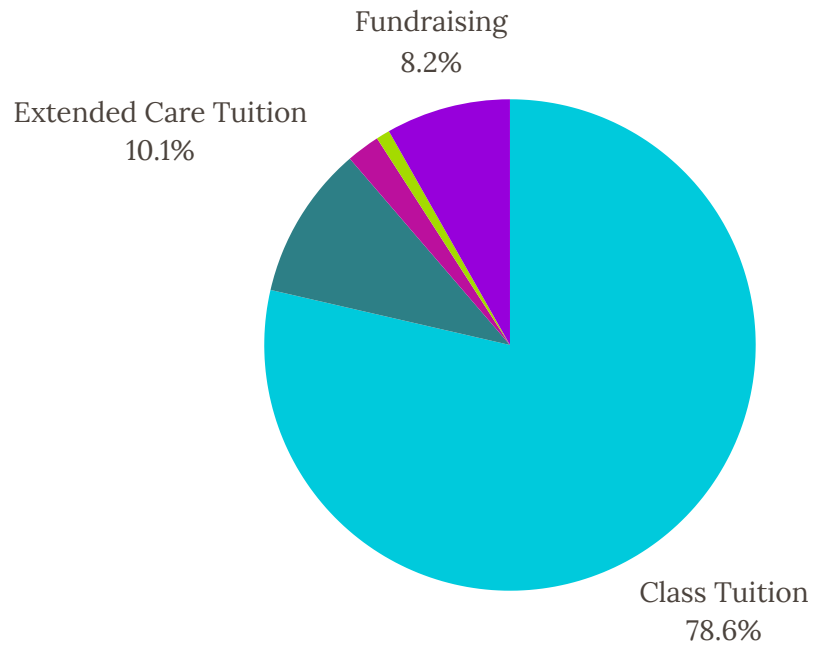
# FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS

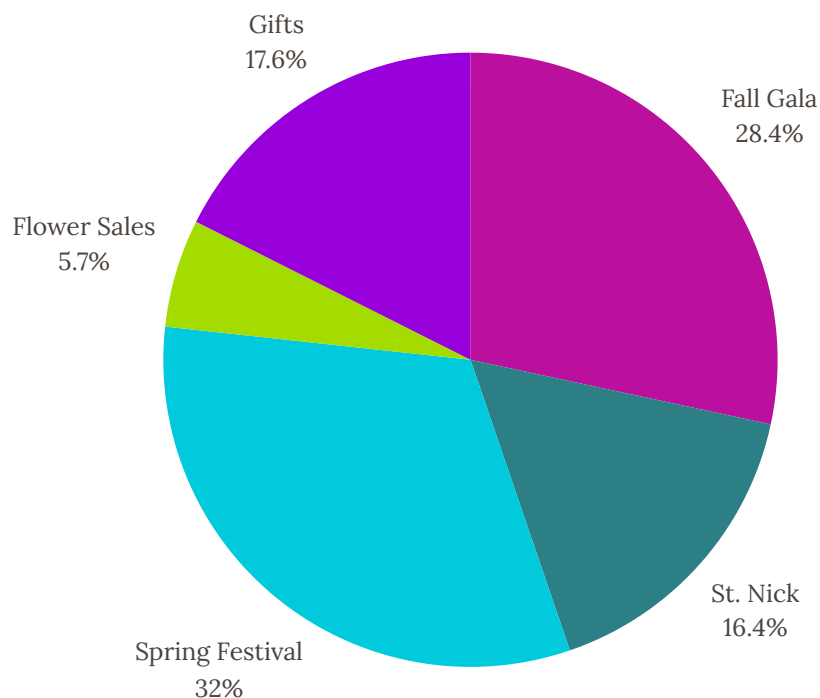
